

RICHMOND CITY CORPORATION
ORDINANCE 2006-6

WHEREAS the City of Richmond has a responsible for the safety and well-being of citizens and employees using the City streets, and

WHEREAS the removal of snow during the winter may be fraught with danger to both persons and property, and

WHEREAS current regulations are not realistic in view of the Cache Valley climate,

NOW THEREFORE the City Council of Richmond City, County of Cache, State of Utah, hereby adopts, passes, and publishes the following:

AN ORDINANCE REVISING TITLE 11-000, SECTION 11-345 OF
THE *CODE OF REVISED ORDINANCES OF RICHMOND (1975,*
ADOPTED 1976) TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS FOR
VEHICLE PARKING ON CITY STREETS AND ROADS DURING
THE WINTER.

1. The current Section 11-345 copyrighted 1976 is hereby revoked in its entirety.
2. Section 11-345, Title 11-000, of the *Code of Revised Ordinances of Richmond (1975, Adopted 1976)* will now read:

11-345. **WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS.** It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle, or any vehicle towed, pulled, or otherwise associated with motor vehicles, to park such a vehicle on any street or road of Richmond City between ten (10) p.m. and seven (7) a.m. between November 1st and March 31st. Drivers may park for no longer than five (5) minutes in the event of loading or unloading passengers only if the vehicle is plainly marked with operating four-way flashing lights. Vehicles loading or unloading property at a commercial facility may park up to a maximum of thirty (30) minutes only if the vehicle is plainly marked with operating four-way flashing lights and active loading or unloading is taking place.
