## **2017 NOTICE OF ELECTION RICHMOND CITY, UTAH**

Richmond City will hold its municipal election this fall to elect a mayor and three (3) council members.

The Primary Election, if needed, is on Tuesday, August 15, 2017.

The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017.

The Richmond City election is non-partisan.

The Mayor and two (2) Council Members will serve four (4) year terms and one (1) council member will serve a two (2) year term and all are elected at large.

The incumbents are:

**\*\*\*Note: When signing up for a council member position the applicant must indicate if applying for a four (4) year term or a two (2) year term.\*\*\***

Those interested in filing for one of these offices must:

- Be a United States citizen at the time of filing
- Be a registered voter of Richmond City
- Be at least 18 years old
- Be a resident of Richmond City for at least 365 consecutive days immediately preceding the date of the general election; November 7, 2017

Each person seeking to become a candidate for a municipal office shall file a Declaration of Candidacy in person at the city office building located at 6 West Main, Richmond, Utah during regular office hours from Thursday, June 1, 2017 through Wednesday, June 7, 2017.

The required filing form is available at the city office building.

There is not a filing fee.
