

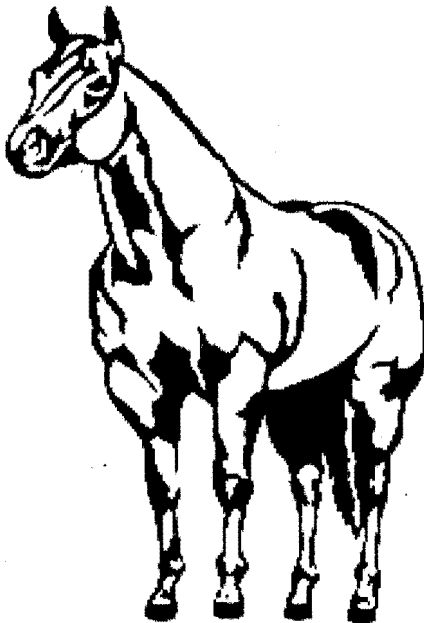

Before any horse may enter the ring, it must be properly entered on the registration forms provided at the registration booth. Breeds will be shown separately if numbers warrant. Six placings will be made in each class. Trophies and/or ribbons will be awarded. High point buckles will be awarded from points earned in underlined classes for under 18, and 19 and up. 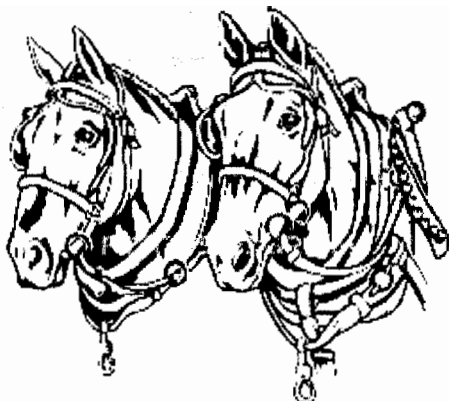
