## **2019 NOTICE OF ELECTION RICHMOND CITY, UTAH**

Richmond City will hold its municipal election this fall to elect three (3) council members.

The Primary Election, if needed, is on Tuesday, August 13, 2019.

The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

The Richmond City election is non-partisan.

The Council Members will serve four (4) year terms and all are elected at large.

The incumbents are:

Council Seat	Kelly Crafts
Council Seat	Paul Erickson
Council Seat	Tucker Thatcher

Those interested in filing for one of these offices must:

- Be a United States citizen at the time of filing
- Be a registered voter of Richmond City
- Be at least 18 years old
- Be a resident of Richmond City for at least 365 consecutive days immediately preceding the date of the general election; November 5, 2019
- Not be a convicted felon

Each person seeking to become a candidate for a municipal office shall file a Declaration of Candidacy in person at the Park Community Center located at 90 South 100 West, Richmond, Utah from Monday, June 3, 2019 through Friday, June 7, 2019 from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. daily.

The required filing form is available at the city office building.

There is not a filing fee.
