It has become necessary to further restrict water turns effective August 27, 2016

City Turns

Restricted City Turns will be effective Saturday, August 27, 2016.

- All city users with **odd numbered** houses west of 1st East will be allowed to water from **7:00 A.M. Saturday to 7:00 P.M. Saturday.**
- All city users with **odd numbered** houses east of 1st East will be allowed to water from **7:00 P.M. Saturday to 7:00 A.M. Sunday.**
- All city users with **even numbered** houses west of 1st East will be allowed to water from **7:00 A.M. Sunday to 7:00 P.M. Sunday.**
- All city users with **even numbered** houses east of 1st East will be allowed to water from **7:00 P.M. Sunday to 7:00 A.M. Monday.**
- Each stockholder will be allowed one sprinkler head (7/32 or less in size) per share of stock. **Those who use more heads than allowed will be ticketed.**
- Houses with automatic sprinkler systems that use more than 10 gallons per minute per share owned, will need to water fewer hours accordingly. Contact the Water master (Chris Hart 890-4382) to arrange hours.

Field Turns

Field Turns are in effect and under the control of the water master.

- Without exception, no one is allowed to turn their water on without permission from the Water master. If you want a field turn, it is your responsibility to notify the Water master, 890-4382.
- All field turns north of North Cache Middle School must shut off from 6 a.m. Sat. until 6 a.m. Mon. unless otherwise instructed by the water master.

Section 76-10-202, Utah Code, makes is a Class B Misdemeanor if a person “—willfully uses any greater quantity of water than has been duly distributed to him/her—“.

Anyone who does not adhere to the guidelines of this letter will be subject to prosecution.

For any question, or suspected violations, please contact a member of the Board of Directors listed below. Your name will be kept confidential.

- The only people allowed to use irrigation water are stockholders who own at least one share of stock and have paid the hookup fee (hookup fee is not required if water is drawn directly from the canal). Do not allow a neighbor to hook up to your system, without first checking with the Board of Directors.
- **No open hoses are allowed.**
- If you are a landlord, and have tenants who use your irrigation water, it is your responsibility to get a copy of this letter to them.

The irrigation season begins on April 1st, and ends on November 1st each year. It is the Stockholder's responsibility to open their drains in the fall, and close them in the spring before April 1st. Water may come into the lines at anytime on, or after April 1st each year.
