

RICHMOND CITY COUNCIL

October 31, 2006

A special meeting of the Richmond City Council was held at the Richmond Community Building located at 6 West Main, Richmond, UT on October 31, 2006. The meeting began at 5:30 p.m. Mayor Michael Hall was in the chair. The opening remarks were made by Marlowe Adkins.

The following Council members were in attendance: Brad Jensen, Terrie Wierenga, Keith Ward, and Leslie Erickson. Allen Lundgreen was excused.

MAYOR HALL: This special City Council meeting has been legally posted and announced for the sole purpose of discussing and possibly passing a single ordinance relative to annexation of property owned by the Gibbons Family Trust. I wish the Council to know that a “protest” lodged by Mr. Jerry Woodland was submitted by him to the County Clerks office with a copy to the City on October 18, 2006. The County has determined that Mr. Woodland’s letter was, in fact, a complaint rather than a protest in the legal sense. As a result we are clear to proceed with the annexation of the land, resulting in this meeting.

LESLIE: How was his “protest” determined to be a complaint?

MAYOR HALL: Mr. Woodland listed five areas of concern, none of which actually dealt with the legality of the annexation of the land. He was concerned with a property boundary dispute between his land and that of a neighbor, hunting taking place on both sides of a city property, lack of access from the east and south sides of the property, the reduction of property lots from 20 acres to 10 acres, and wildlife habitat.

KEITH: I move that we pass Ordinance 2006-7 “An Ordinance to Annex Certain Described Land into the Corporate Limits of Richmond City, County of Cache, State of Utah.”

LESLIE: I second the motion.

****The motion passed with four “ayes” with one member absent.***

A motion to adjourn was made by Terrie, seconded by Leslie, and passed with four “ayes” with one member absent.

Meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
