

RICHMOND CITY COUNCIL

JUNE 28, 2012

A special meeting of the Richmond City Council was held at the Richmond City Office Building located at 6 West Main, Richmond, Utah on Thursday, June 28, 2012. The meeting began at 7:00 A.M., Mayor Michael Hall was in the Chair.

The following Council members were in attendance: Brad Jensen (via conference call), Terrie Wierenga, and Paul Erickson. C.J. Sorenson and Jeff Young were excused.

MAYOR: We only have a couple of things to address. The paying of bills for the ending of the budget year and the purchase of two newer/used dump trucks for the City. This will upgrade our trucks by about 25 years. We have been looking for a new or used dump truck for a couple of years and a salesperson we have asked to help us in this search has located a couple of trucks. The total cost of both trucks would be \$68,800 and that includes the snow plowing apparatus as well on each truck.

JUSTIN: The trucks are both 1998 International Model 2574. One with 25,000 miles and the other with 125,000 miles but they both have the same hours. We have been setting aside funds in the Capital Projects Fund just for the purpose of purchasing a new truck or two used trucks at some point. Originally we thought we might have to spend over \$100,000 for a new one. This is great that we can get two trucks for significantly less than one new one.

MAYOR: Scott (Ball) and Charles (Chism) went down and looked them over and said they will do exactly what we need and are in good condition for their age and number of miles. The only additional purchase we will need, that I am aware of, is that one of the trucks will need a stainless sander.
