## Dog & Kennel Licenses

Dog and dog kennel licenses are now ready for you to obtain. License fee for dogs remains the same as last year: \$5 if spayed or neutered and paid for by March 1<sup>st</sup>; \$10 if paid for after March 1<sup>st</sup>. "Intact" dogs are \$10 and will double in cost to \$20 after March 1<sup>st</sup>. Proof of a current rabies vaccination is required for each dog.

Renewal of kennel licenses will be \$50 if purchased before March 1<sup>st</sup>, \$100 after that date. A new kennel license (required if you have three or more dogs on your property) must be approved through the Planning & Zoning Commission and the Richmond City Council. Contact the City Office for details.



## Annual Rabies Clinic

The rabies clinic will be held at the Fire Station on Saturday, February 8<sup>th</sup> from 10 a.m. until noon. Valley Veterinary Service will provide the vaccinations at a cost of \$15.00 each. You may also get your City Dog License at the same time; however, you will

have to provide two separate payments – one to Valley Vet and the other to the City.

## Business Licenses

All business licenses expired on December 31, 2013. The 2014 business licenses are ready to be picked up. Most will cost \$25.00 but if you did not get your 2013 license the current cost for 2013-2014 will be \$75.00. If you did not pick up a license for two years in a row, it has completely expired and you will need to be approved by the City Council to get a new license. A penalty fee will be added to any 2014 license not paid for by March 31, 2014.

Experience is not necessary; we will train you. All certification classes will be paid for by the Department with a commitment of service from you.


