

FAQ's

What time should my cans be to the curb for collection?

All containers should be set out for collection by 7:00 AM on your collection day, especially on holiday make-up days. Cans should be placed with the front of the container facing the street. As per city ordinance, please do not allow your containers to sit out on the street longer than 24 hours before and after collection services.

How much space should be between my cans and other objects?

Place cans 3 to 4 feet away from other containers, mail boxes, cars, snow banks, etc. and in a straight line with the other containers along the street.

What if I have extra garbage or recycling?

Make sure all your material is placed inside your containers for pickup. If you have extra, please call our office to determine how we can best assist you. We offer dumpster rentals and other special collection options for a fee.

How can I remember my recycling schedule?

Text and e-mail reminders of holidays and the recycling collection schedule are available! Sign up on our website at www.loganutah.org.

Take Care of your Cans

Don't leave your can on the curb! Cans should be put out to the curb no earlier than the evening before your collection day and returned to their storage location on your collection day! Report a broken can online or by calling our office!

Green Waste

Curbside green waste cans are available for a \$4/month fee in select cities. For more information please visit our website or call our offices. A list of seasonal green waste drop sites located throughout Cache County is available on our website.
