Online Bill Pay

Richmond City will be offering online bill pay in January. Information will be provided via the city website, Facebook, and Parlant communication system.

Winter Parking Ordinance

The Winter Parking Ordinance is in effect from November 1st through March 31st. Vehicles CANNOT be parked on city streets from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily or a citation can be written. Please help us keep your vehicles safe from damage and our snowplow drivers safe as well. Remove your garbage can(s) from the roadside on Friday as soon as possible. The snowplow truck drivers try to avoid hitting the cans at any time but sometimes it happens and we want to keep your cans undamaged and our drivers safe.

Please DO NOT push or blow the snow from your driveway and sidewalk into or across the city street. Also, please do not push snow from your driveway across the road into your neighbor's yard. When snow is pushed or blown into a city road, it can freeze and create a hazard for motorists as well as cause damage to the city's snowplow trucks.

Clear the sidewalk in front of your home and if you can, assist your neighbors in clearing theirs. The council is always concerned about the safety of people walking. When sidewalks are not clear, people will walk in the road which can be dangerous for both motorists and those walking to their destination. We also recommend you park your vehicles and keep other personal items off the street as far as possible. The snowplow trucks can throw snow, ice, and debris 12 to 15 feet on average

from the city road and we want to avoid damage if possible.
