

**RICHMOND CITY CORPORATION
RESOLUTION 2015-3**

WHEREAS, the up-keep and maintenance of streets and roads within the limits of Richmond City are under the supervision of the Richmond City Council, and

WHEREAS, Richmond City has the obligation to ensure that displacement of street and road surface(s) is/are corrected in a manner complying with City standards, and

WHEREAS, there have been instances wherein outside individuals and companies have failed to comply with such standards resulting in non-budgeted expenses being incurred by the City,

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of Richmond City, Utah, hereby adopts, passes and publishes the following:

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A NON-REFUNDABLE FEE OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) FOR STREET CUTS AUTHORIZED BY RICHMOND CITY.

1. Any party or parties seeking to open the surface of a street or road must first obtain a permit from Richmond City per Richmond City Ordinance 99-2.
 - a. The applicant must provide the City the location of the proposed cut, the purpose for the cut, the estimated time that traffic on the street or road will be disrupted, and the estimated date and/or time that the location will be fully restored to City standards.
2. Upon the granting of approval for the cut and prior to any actual work that disrupts the street or road, the responsible party will provide the City a certified check made payable to Richmond City Corporation in the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500).
3. This fee is non-refundable.
